Founded in 1947, Powell Industries is the strategic supplier of choice for companies that utilize highly complex and integrated systems for critical processes related to electrical energy, including distribution and control.

## **Business Challenge**

In 2009, Powell's business was growing substantially and they recognized an opportunity to shift some of their floor space from component assembly to the manufacturing of their end products. This project lead them to explore a variety of other options for alternate manufacturing space. Powell already utilized a supplier in Juarez, Mexico, but this would not allow the freedom or flexibility that a shelter operation would provide.

As an alternative to building a new facility or adding space, Powell sought a partner with the expertise and experience to oversee a portion of their subassemblies, which would allow them to effectively accommodate and manage their growing business. Powell ultimately engaged NovaLink in June of 2009 to manage their surplus manufacturing needs given NovaLink's proven history of supplying and delivering high quality subassemblies.
